## **Religious artefacts activities**

### Christianity

Read through the instructions below and nominate group members for each of the tasks.

Look at each of the artefacts in the Christianity box.

Sort them into these groups:

- Church of England
- Roman Catholic
- Eastern Orthodox
- Evangelical / Protestant Churches

In the RE IT resources or on Google images find a picture of each of these types of Churches. Label and print it.

Print labels for all the artefacts that you can identify.

Make a display with the four Church pictures Bluetacked on the wall behind a table.

Display the artefacts on the table with strings or paper strips showing which artefacts could be found in each Church. Some may be found in more than one church.

Get one member of your group to be a member of one of the pictured churches who will talk to the whole group about some of the artefacts, their significance and which Christian beliefs they demonstrate.

Another group member should ask the whole group if they have any questions about the artefacts or the differences between what happens in the Churches.

Write two sets of questions, KS1 and KS2, for children to answer about the Christian artefacts. Display these by the Church pictures.
